



Dishwashers Needed for Occasional Event Work

What Does It Take?

You will need to lift heavy trays, enjoy dishpan hands and as a bonus receive a moisturizing facial from the steam of the dish sanitizer. We will ask you to wear sturdy, closed toe shoes and clean, comfortable clothing that you don't mind getting wet. If you are working for an event, we may ask you to wear black pants and black shirt.

How Does It Work?

This is On Call work for which we pay \$15.00 per hour. We'll call or email you when we have event needs coming up and book the first responders. You will have our unending gratitude and occasionally there is food to enjoy as a bonus!
