



Dear Camp Community,

We know many in our community have been directly affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic. Each of you continues to be in our thoughts and we are hoping you are all safe, healthy, and well during this challenging moment in time.

We are working hard to continue to plan Summer Farm Camps while ensuring the safety of our campers, staff, and community. Below are some answers to frequently asked questions about 2020 Camps:

Will farm camp run this summer?

We are hoping to run summer camps as they are currently scheduled.

At this point in time (as of 5/7/2020), out of an abundance of caution we have preventatively rescheduled our first two weeks of camp. As the situation develops, we will continue to modify as necessary to ensure camper and community safety. Please see our website for the current camp schedule.

Will half-day cooking camps run this summer?

We have made the difficult decision to cancel our two half-day cooking camps taught by Seattle Cucina. Attendees of these camps will have received an email with more information.

What changes are being made to make farm camp safer?

We are delaying the start of camp until mid-July. When and if camps launch, social distancing measures will be implemented that may include smaller group sizes, strategic use of our campus space, increased sanitation, an aggressive cleaning regimen, and more. As these decisions and plans are finalized, we will update this document and our website.

How are decisions being made?

We are closely following the guidance and recommendations from Governor Inslee and the King County Health Department to make informed decisions while prioritizing the farm's ability to feed our community.

If I cancel my child's registration, will I receive a full refund?

Yes. The health of our community is our first priority. We have changed our cancellation policy this year to better meet the needs of our community at this time. You will receive a refund for the full cost of camp, including fees that would in normal circumstances be nonrefundable.
