The 21 Acres Sustainability Library contains more than 1000 titles on topics like gardening, cooking, green living, climate and social issues, children's books, and more. This is also one of our few indoor volunteer roles – perfect for those rainy days.

Time Commitment: 1-2 hours per week. Day of the week and timing to be determined based on volunteer availability.

Age Requirement: Volunteers ages 13-15 need an adult participant volunteering with them, and anyone under the age of 18 needs parent/guardian permission.
